INTERNATIONAL SCIENTIFIC AND PROFESSIONAL CONFERENCE "HEALTH OF WORKING-AGE AND OLDER ADULTS"

UP FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, IZOLA, SLOVENIA 19 & 20 SEPTEMBER 2024

All abstracts of active participants at the scientific and professional international conference "Health of Working-Age and Older Adults" will be reviewed and published in the online Book of Abstracts, which will be available on the conference website https://www.healthconference.fvz.upr.si/program-en.html

The topics for presentations should be in line with the main topics of the conference:

- CONCERNS, CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES IN THE HEALTH OF WORKING-AGE AND OLDER ADULTS (chronic diseases, health of marginalised and vulnerable groups, women's health/men's health),
- MENTAL HEALTH OF WORKING-AGE AND OLDER ADULTS,
- NUTRITION AND HEALTH OF WORKING-AGE AND OLDER ADULTS,
- ICT SOLUTIONS FOR HEALTH OF WORKING-AGE AND OLDER ADULTS,
- CHALLENGES IN HUMAN FACTORS, PHYSICAL (IN)ACTIVITY AND SEDENTARY BEHAVIOUR AMONG WORKING-AGE AND OLDER ADULTS,
- PREVENTION AND REHABILITATION FOR WORKING-AGE AND OLDER ADULTS.

The conference will consist of a plenary session with invited speakers and regular sessions.

In addition to these, the conference will also feature a poster session, where speakers will present their contributions in a succinct and concise manner. Guidelines for preparing a poster can be read at https://www.healthconference.fvz.upr.si/contributions.html

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Deadline for abstract submission: April 15, 2024

Contributors have to submit an abstract in the English language (maximum **from 2000 to 3000 characters**, excluding title, authors' names and affiliations, keywords). The length of the title should not exceed 100 characters (including spaces). Authors should provide from 3 to 5 keywords.

The Scientific Committee will arrange for the translation into the Slovenian language for those whose mother language is not Slovenian.

You can submit either a **professional** or a **scientific** abstract.

Scientific abstracts should comprise the following four sections:

- Introduction,
- Methods,
- Results,
- Discussion and conclusions.

Professional abstracts do not have to follow the above structure, but the following sections are recommended:

- Introduction and objective,
- Content presentation,
- Conclusions.

Authors for whom English is not the first language should have their abstracts proofread by a native English speaker.

Authors are advised to use the abstract template and the styles defined in the template when submitting their abstract.

Active participants will register for the conference after their abstract has been accepted by the Scientific Committee.

The abstract should be submitted electronically as a Word document to the following e-mail address: conference@fvz.upr.si When submitting your abstract, please also indicate the title of the section/ topic of the Conference, for which you are submitting the abstract. The file should be named after the surname and first name of the first author (e.g. NOVAK_TANJA_abstract.doc). In the case of multiple abstract submissions, a sequential number should be added to the file name (e.g. NOVAK_TANJA_abstract2.doc).

After the review of your abstract, you will receive feedback with the reviewer's opinion to your e-mail address. If any major or minor corrections are proposed by the reviewer, you will be invited to submit a revised version of your abstract. When resubmitting your abstract, please name the file in a way that makes it clear this is a revision (e.g. NOVAK_TANJA_abstract corr.doc).

COBISS Typology

Abstracts will be classified either into Type 1.12 (Published Scientific Conference Contribution Abstract) or 1.13 (Published Professional Conference Contribution Abstract) according to the Slovenian bibliographic system COBISS.
